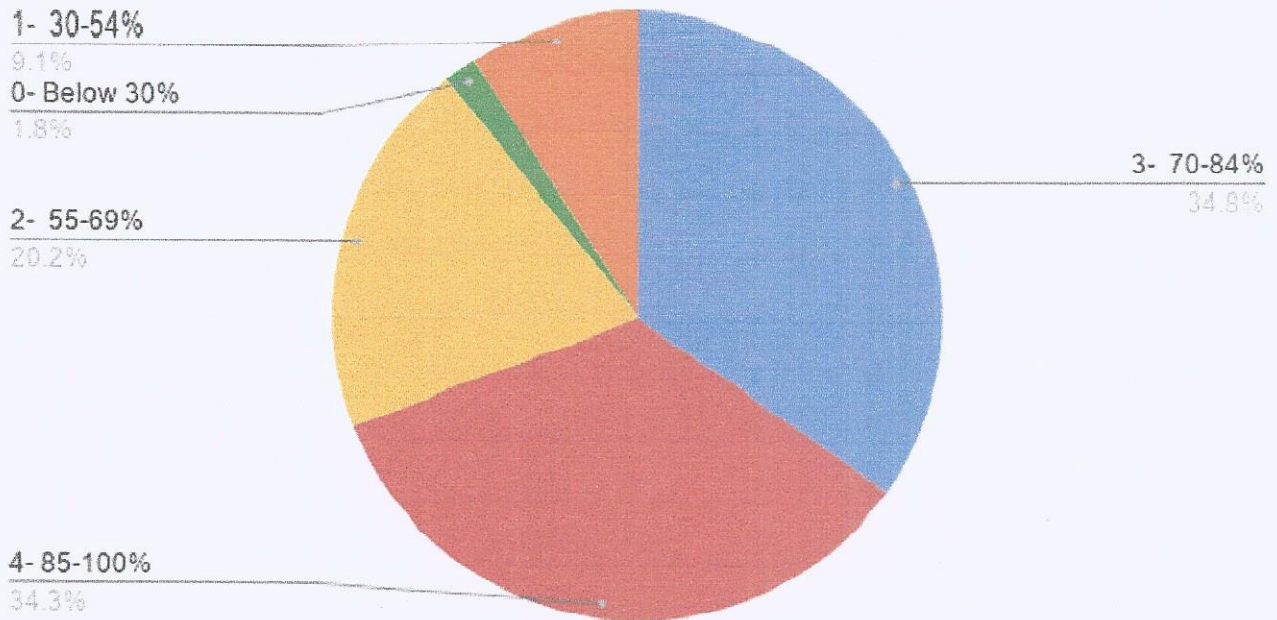

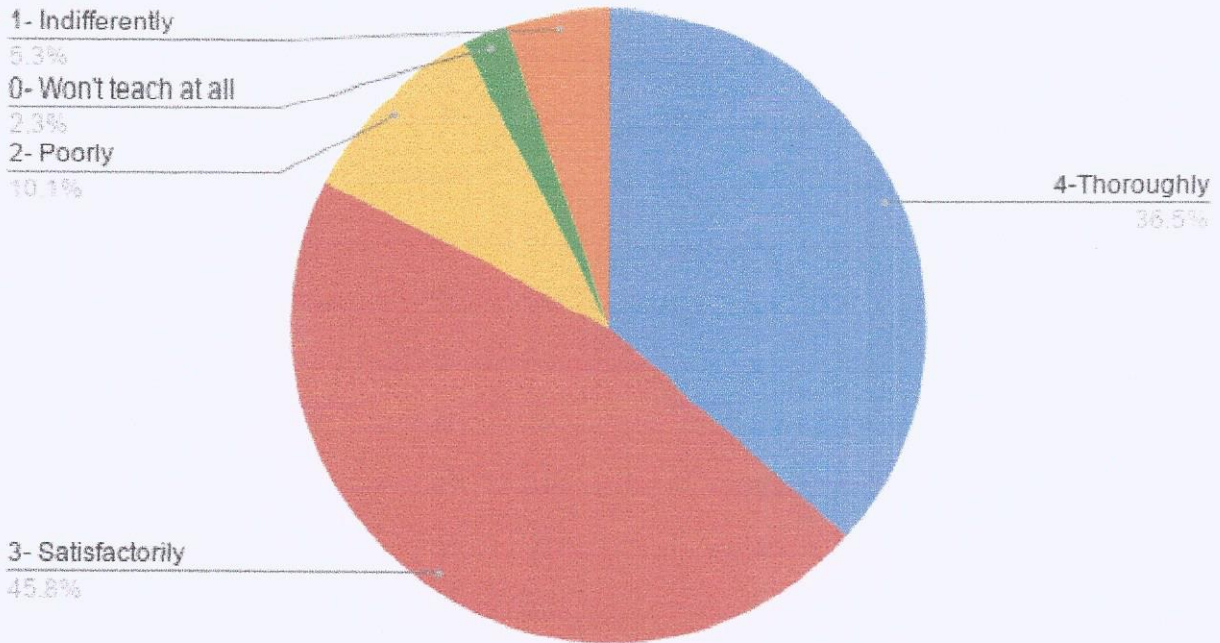

Count of 2. How well did the teacher prepare for the classes?

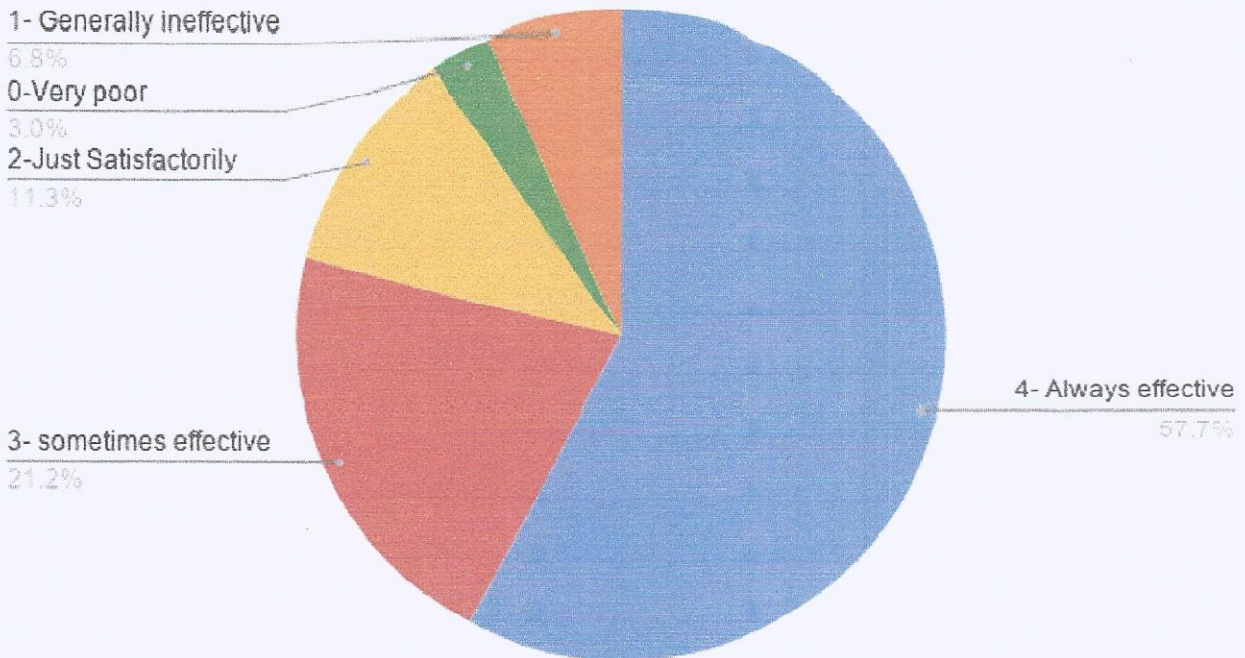

Count of 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

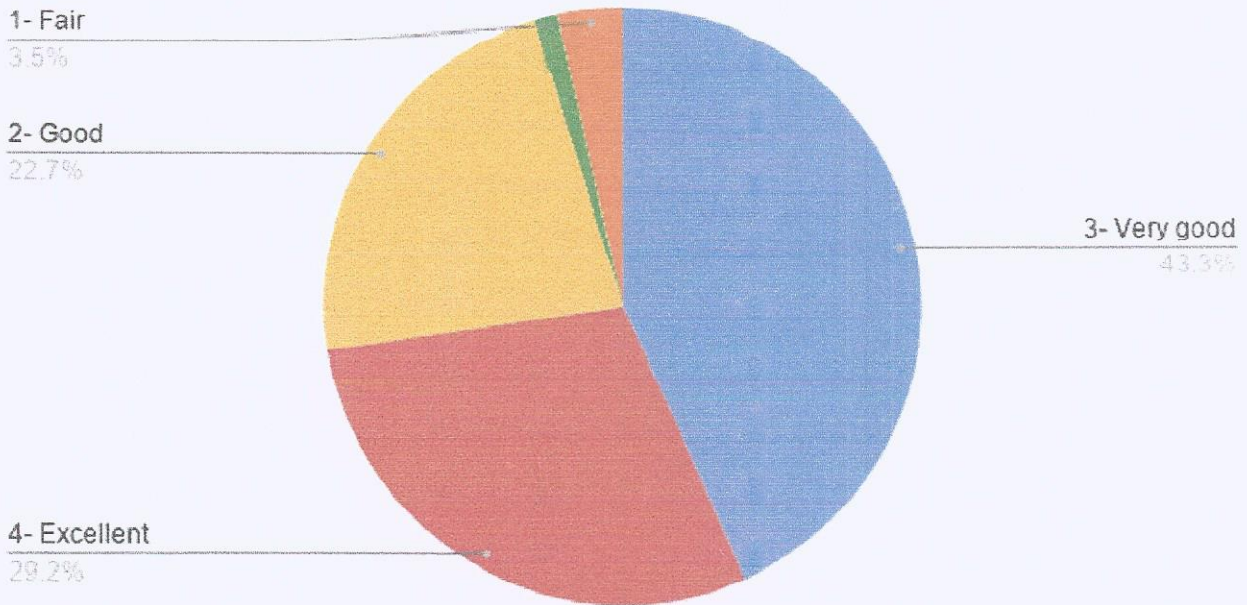

Count of 4. The Teachers approach to teaching can be best described as

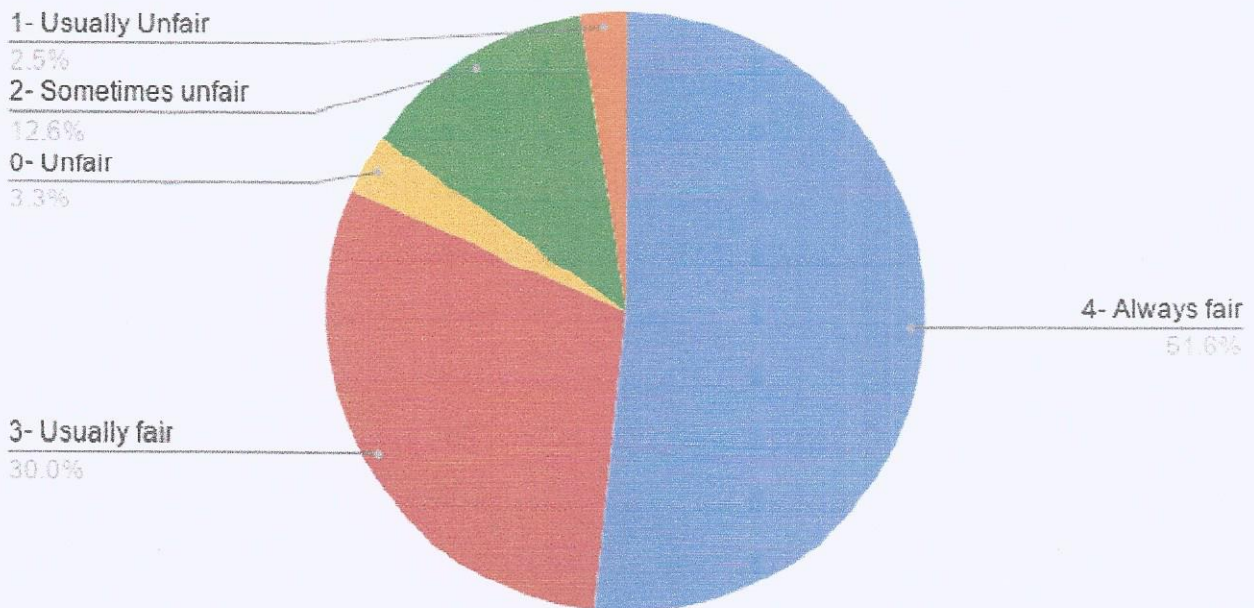

Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by all the teachers

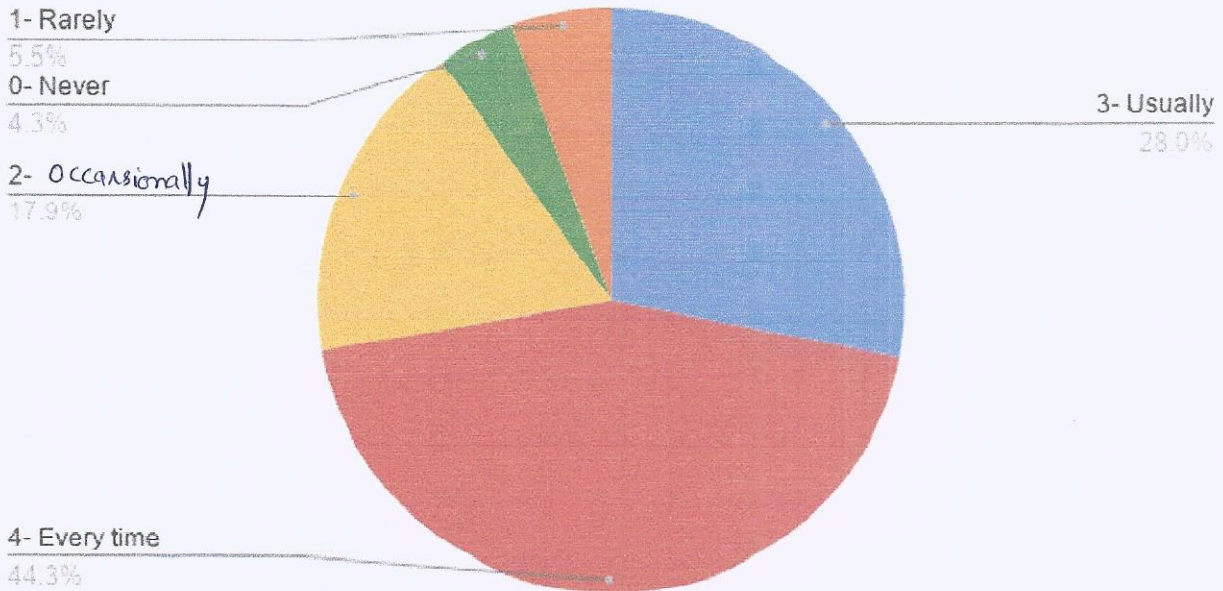

Count of 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



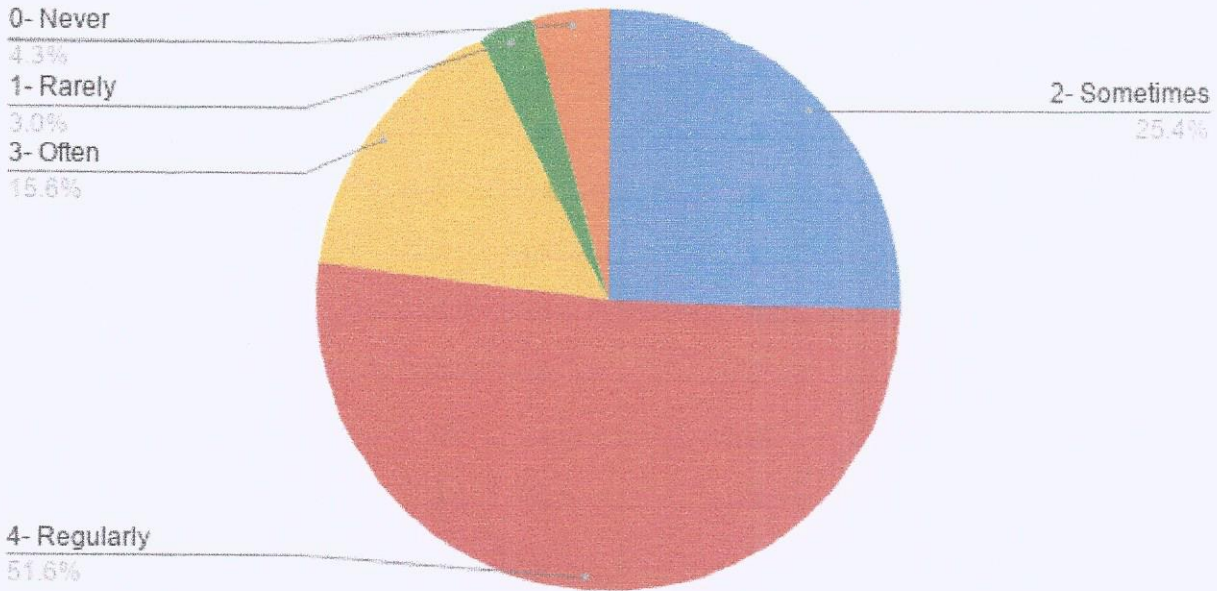

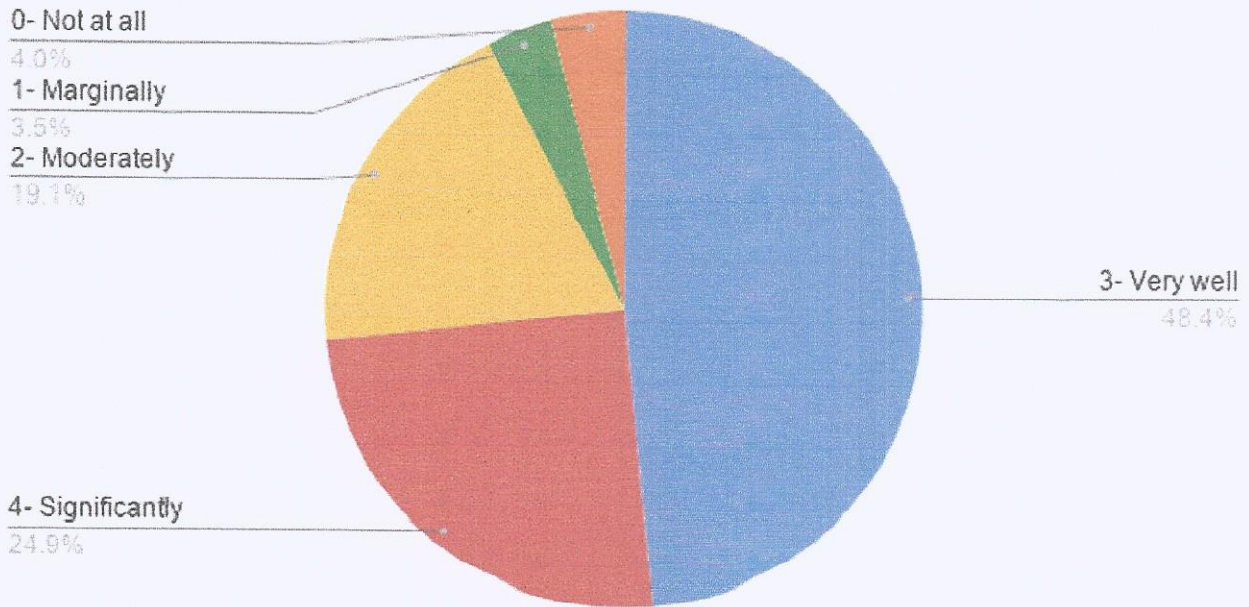

Count of 10- Teachers inform about your expected competencies course outcomes and program outcomes.

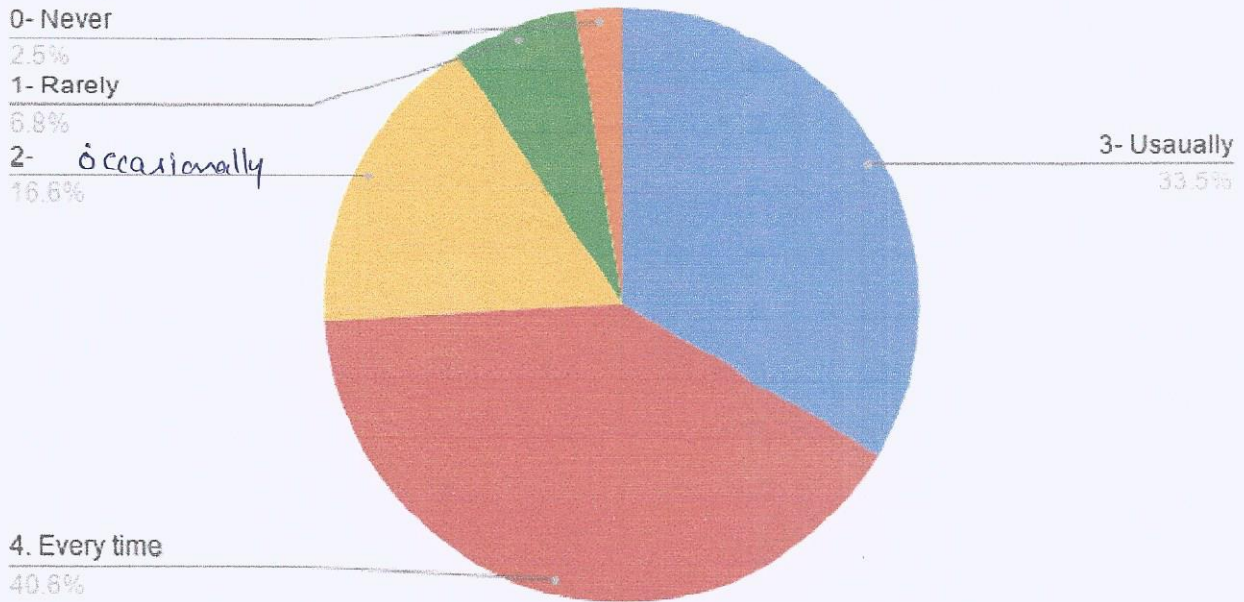

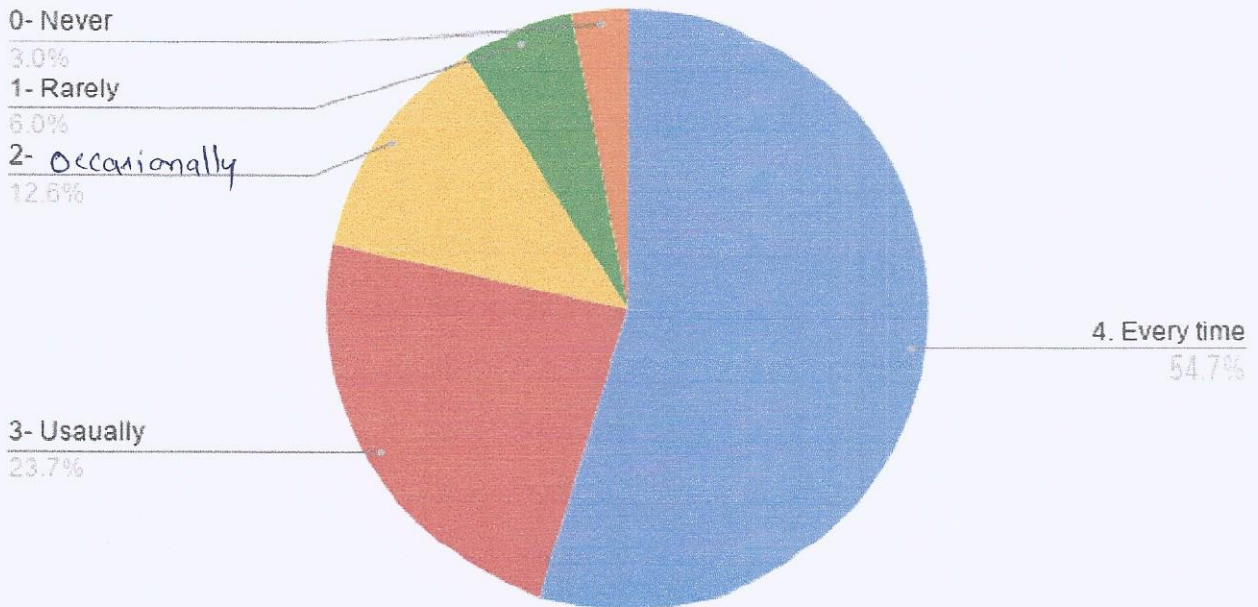

Count of 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

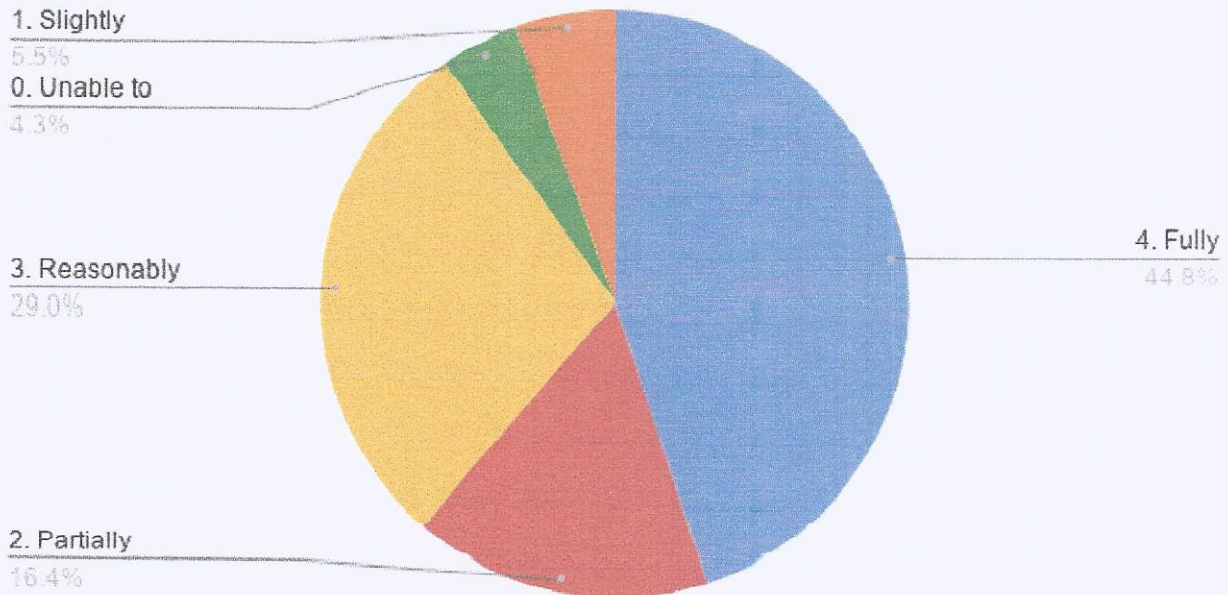

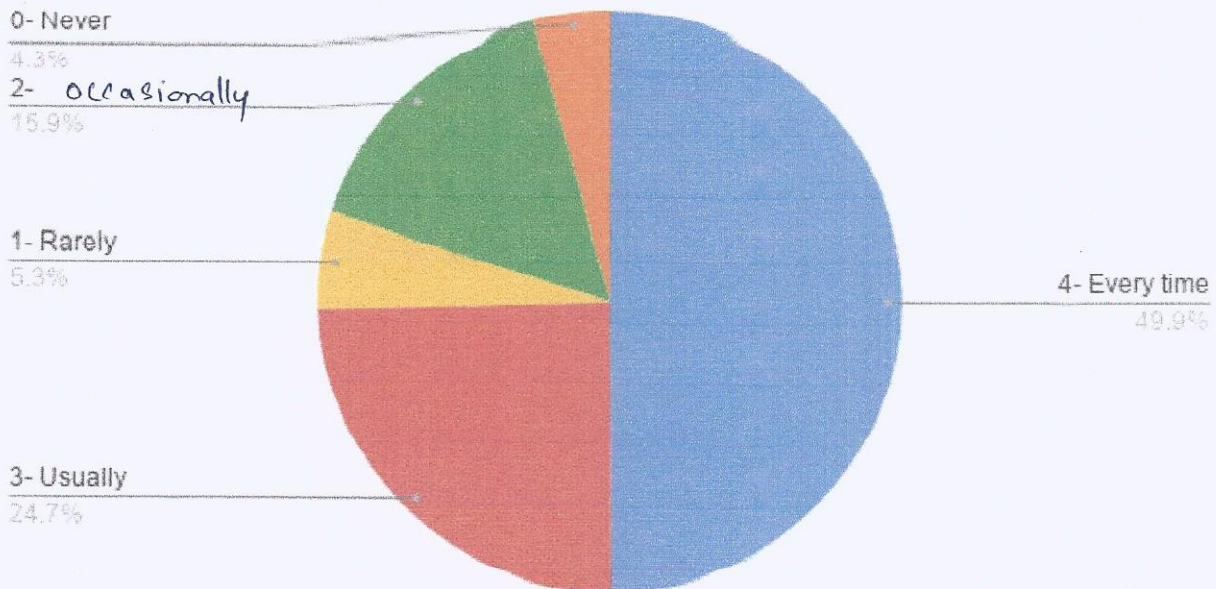

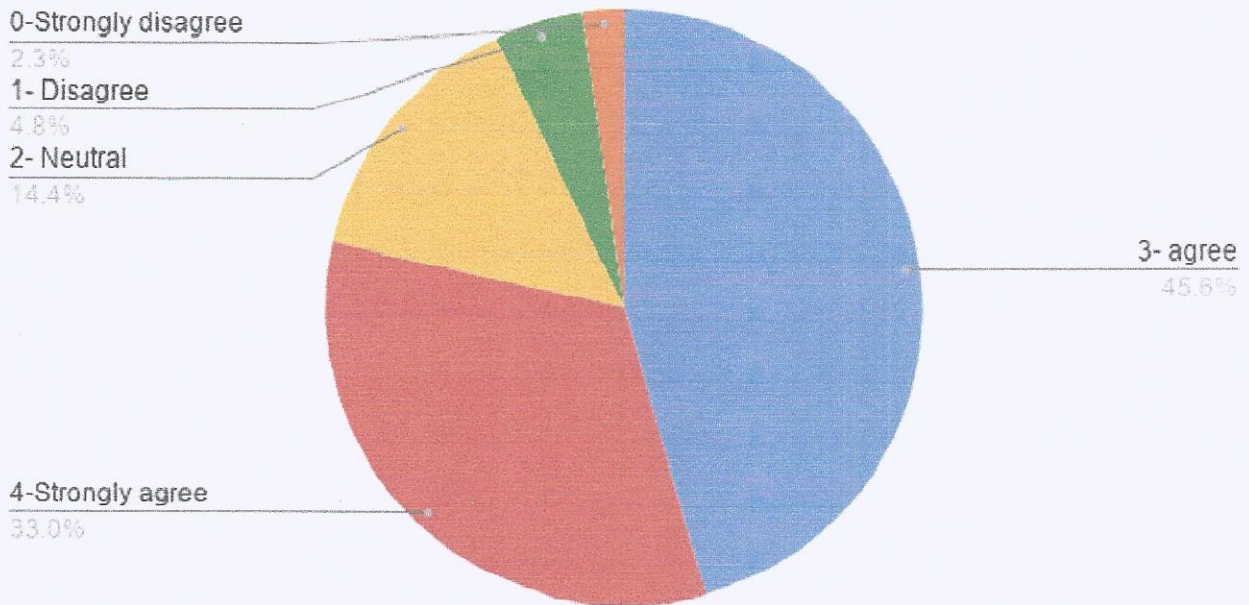

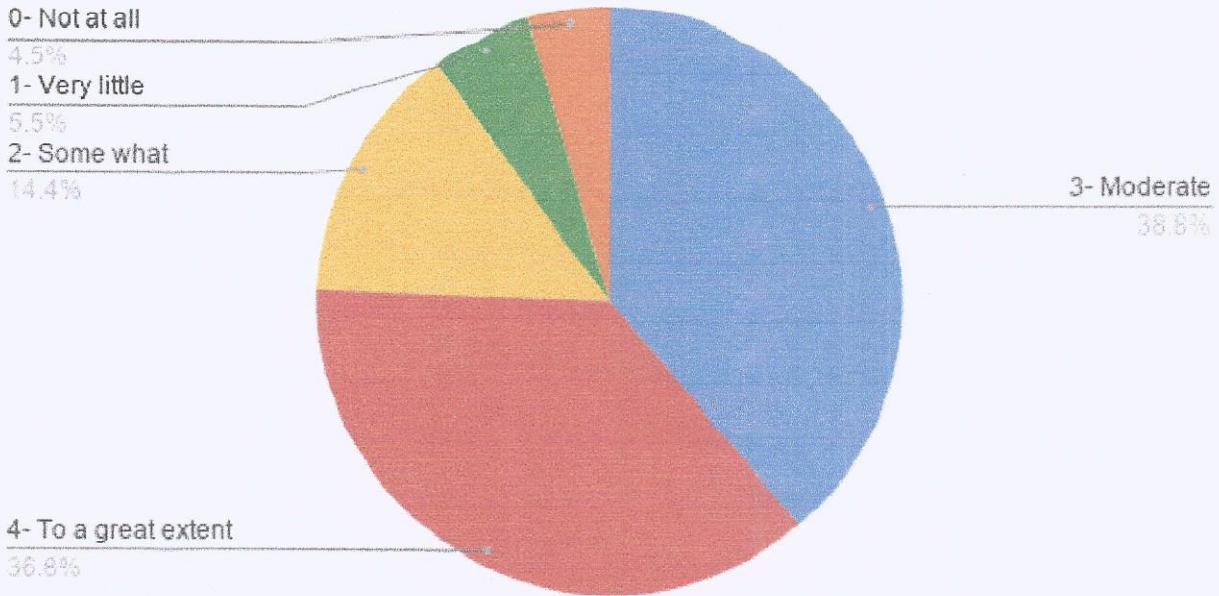

Count of 16. The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning

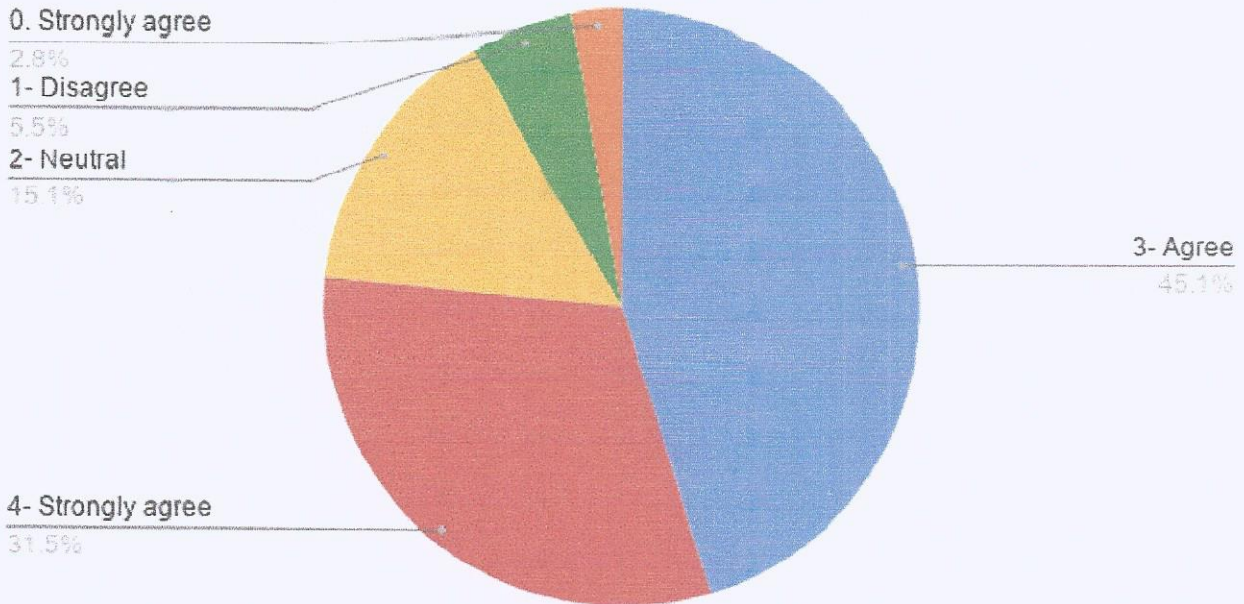

Count of 17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

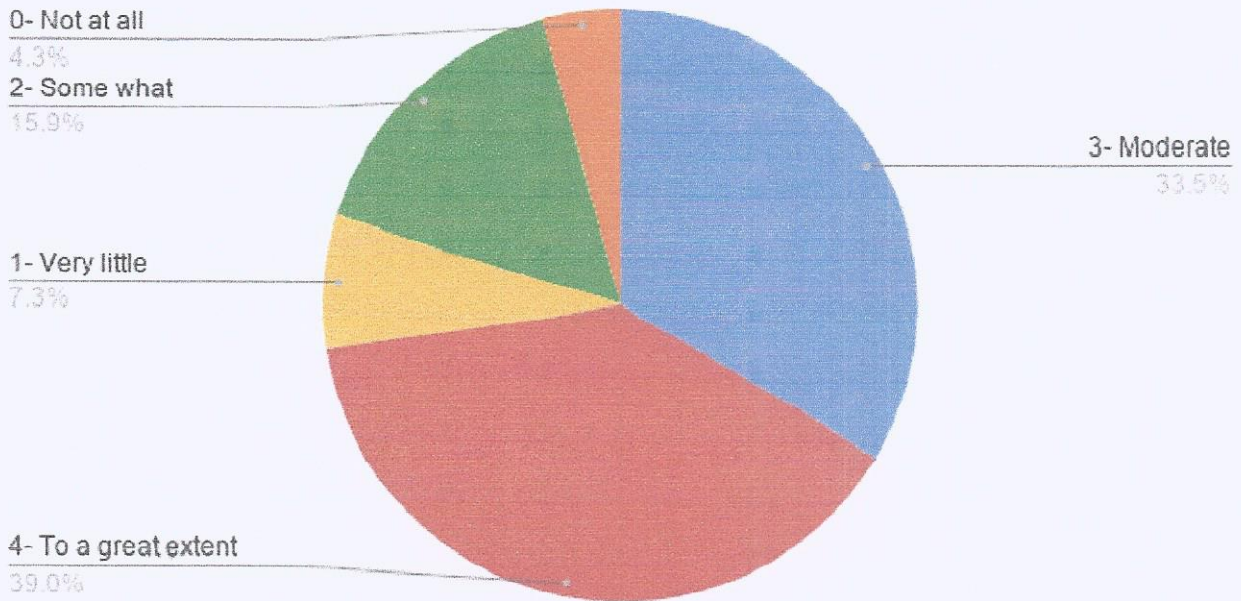

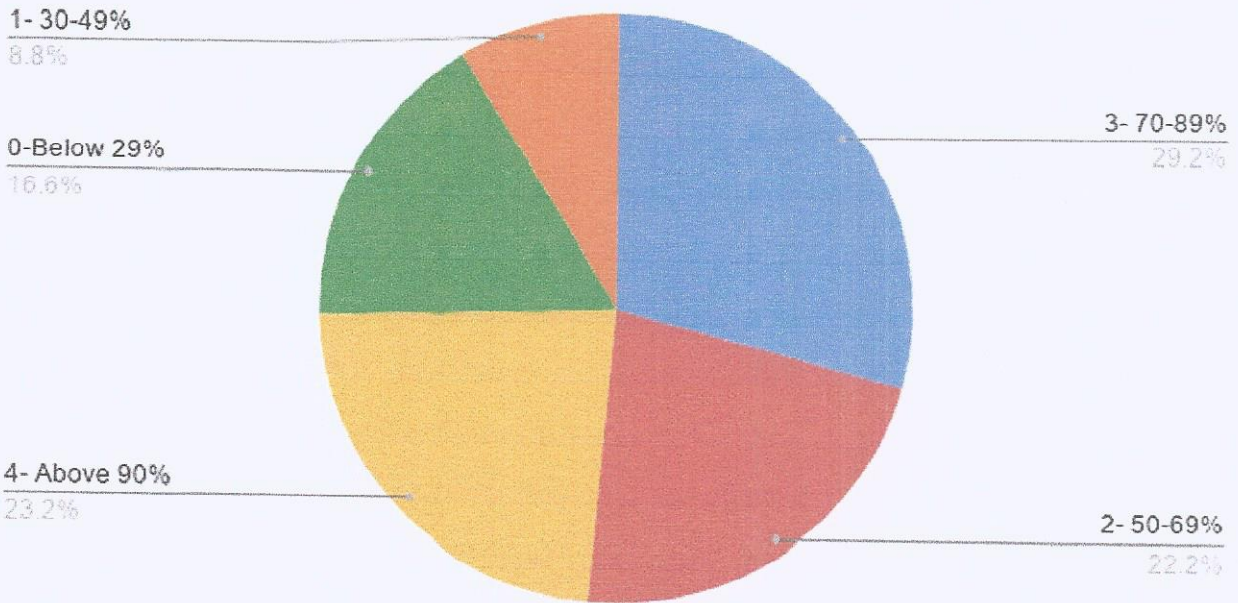

Count of 19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching.

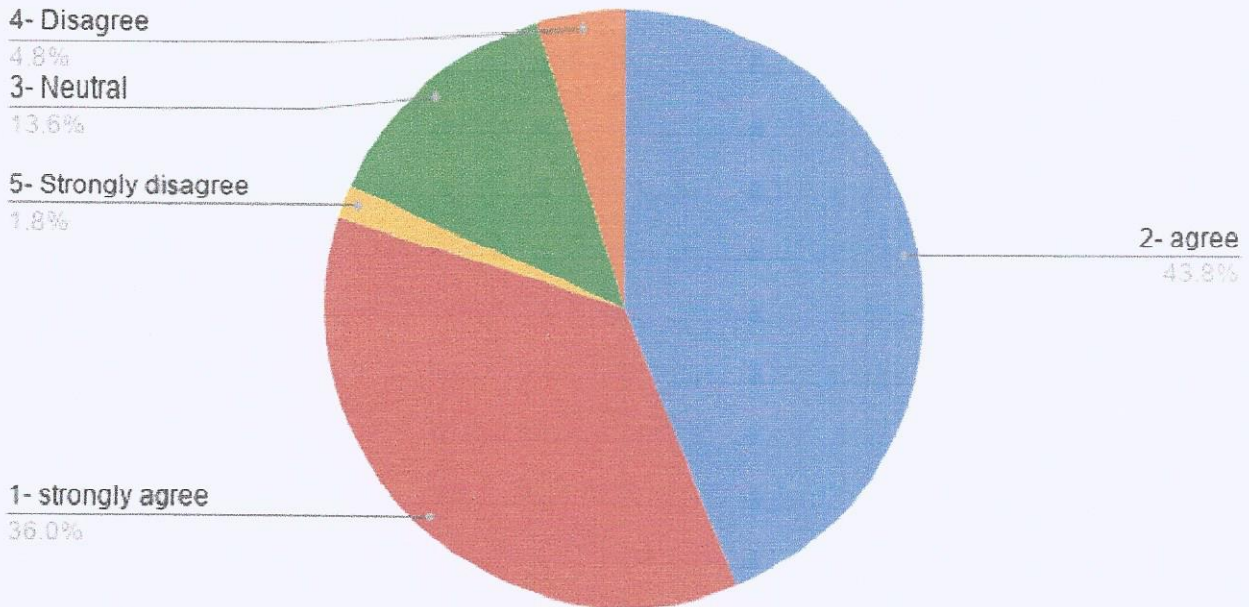
