Our college is well known for its efficient teaching staff, regular classroom teaching and discipline. These all qualities of our college gradually increase the enrollment percentage of students every year. Total online enrollment against intake capacity is found five times more every year and it leaves good impression of our college amidst educational institutions.

In the year 2019-20 total enrollment gone up with 2352, out of this number of boys and girls students was 993 and 1359 respectively. Out of 993 boys number of SC, ST, and OBC were 207, 113 and 621 respectively, while 234, 170 and 861 were girls in this category. In this way total girls enrollment was found to be 57,78% this year. Out of total enrolled students 2295 were appeared in the annul examination and 2123 students passed. Total pass percent was 92,50% this year which was 65% in the session 2018-19.

A student's union is also formed this year through nomination on the merit basis. This nomination is done under the guideline and regulation of Commissioner, Higher Education Department, Raipur, Chhattisgarh. The students union for the year 2019-20 was:
