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Institutional Best Practices

1. "Cleanliness Drive in and around the campus"

> Context - College's NSS unit is very active and working for various awareness and social activities. NSS volunteers are active in the college and acts according to the instruction of NSS Coordinator and Principal of the institution.

> Description of the Best Practice – NSS officer has designed a fifteen days program for Cleanliness Drive in the campus. Student volunteers along with other students of the college carried a systematic cleanliness drive. This drive included removal of weeds from the campus, cleaning and painting of pots and systematic Class Room cleaning etc. In this drive faculties and staff participated equally with the students. This activity is conducted after running regular theory classes of the college.

"Visits to the schools of nearby villages to increase GER" 2.

> Context - Total enrolled students of the college in the year 2015-16 were 1574; it was increased in the year 2016-17 and came to 1924. In this context when college received a circular from Higher Education Department regarding the activities to raise gross enrollment rate, it prompted the administration to design an extensive program of visiting the schools of surrounding villages.

> **Description of the Best Practice** – A notice was circulated deputing fifteen professors to visit various nearby villages. These Professors visited nineteen schools and interacted with the faculties and students. This interaction was to motivate the students to join College after completing their Higher Secondary Examination. This practice was done to raise the GER of the college.
